The EUFMC is a leading educational event for fleets with utility equipment. While the conference experience is filled with learning and networking opportunities, part of the EUFMC tradition includes offering unique activities for attendees, spouses and social guests, and their families. This newsletter is provided to help you plan and make the most of your EUFMC experience.

An EUFMC registration includes access to all EUFMC events including three meals a day Monday through Wednesday. Seats at dinner are reserved for all attendees; registered spouses and social guests are seated with the attendee. Williamsburg is a leading vacation destination. The EUFMC takes place adjacent to Colonial Williamsburg, a living history museum. "Jamestown Settlement - a living history museum" for spouses, social guests and retirees, 9 AM—2 PM. Join us for an outing to the Jamestown Settlement - a recreation of Jamestown as it might have appeared between 1607-1624. Set along the James River just a few miles from Williamsburg we will visit a recreated Powhatan Indian Village and James Fort - a military outpost. Three recreated ships that brought the first permanent English colonists to Virginia are docked at the pier. Come aboard! We'll begin with John Sutton, tour guide, sharing an overview of Jamestown and the importance and history of this area to our young country. Learn the true story of Pocahontas and Captain John Smith. We will see, touch and experience how



the Colonists and Native American Indians lived. There are also extensive gallery exhibits and a gift shop that can be visited.

Lunch for spouses will follow at Le Yaca French restaurant in Williamsburg. Debbie Bruss, retired trainer from Thomson Reuters and etiquette consultant with the Junior Cotillion of Hampton Roads, will lead an etiquette program during the luncheon.

Retirees will depart for lunch with John Sutton.
