

Leadership Expert to Address Fleet Safety at EUFMC



Addressing breakdowns in fleet safety processes and procedures, and driving safety improvements through accountability and effective approaches to leadership, will be the focus of a presentation at the 2024 EUFMC by Eric Kapitulik, founder of The Program, a provider of leadership development and team building services.

A graduate of the United States Naval Academy, Kapitulik served in the U.S. Marine Corps for eight years as an Infantry Officer and a Special Operations Officer. After earning an MBA from the University of Chicago Graduate School of Business, he founded The Program, a team of professionals that teaches organizations how to develop world-class leaders and teams.

In addition to offering key learning points about how great leaders and teams can drive fleet safety improvements, Kapitulik will discuss his experiences in the U.S. Marine Corps, and his survival of a tragic helicopter crash that killed six Marines. He will also detail his subsequent efforts to raise money for a college scholarship fund for the children of his deceased teammates by competing in the world's toughest endurance races and climbing the world's tallest mountains.
