EUFMC SETS ITS SIGHTS ON 2025

Brian Johnson of Alabama Power Company joins the EUFMC Board of Directors

Planning has begun for <u>EUFMC</u>, to be held June 1-4, 2025, at the Williamsburg Lodge and Conference Center in Williamsburg, Virginia. The 72nd annual conference will feature educational and equipment events, special activities and networking opportunities for fleet representatives and manufacturers and suppliers.
