Make plans today to attend the 73<sup>rd</sup> annual EUFMC in Williamsburg, Virginia. In 2026, the conference will take place as the 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the United States of America draws near, in the same Historic Triangle where the nation's story began and its independence was won. Coinciding with the 100th anniversary of Colonial Williamsburg, the 18th-century town and world's largest U.S. history museum, EUFMC 2026 will feature special events and celebrations.

In 2025, EUFMC attendees included 177 fleet representatives from 107 investor-owned utilities, 34 utility contractors, 10 utility cooperatives, 12 municipal operations, and 14 other fleets that operate, manage and maintain utility equipment. Included were 62 new fleet attendees and 4 new companies. Joining the fleets were 350 supplier representatives from 97 companies.
